The initials were designed by Franz Marc and Hans Arp. - Slightly finger-stained, some sheets with diagonal creases, the silk shirts partially damaged. Despite all the defects described, a well preserved copy of the rare, non-rebound paperback edition of the first edition; many copies of this edition are missing the spine title woodcut due to the new binding! £6,400 €7.500
